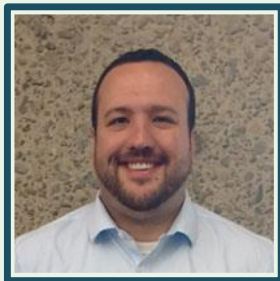

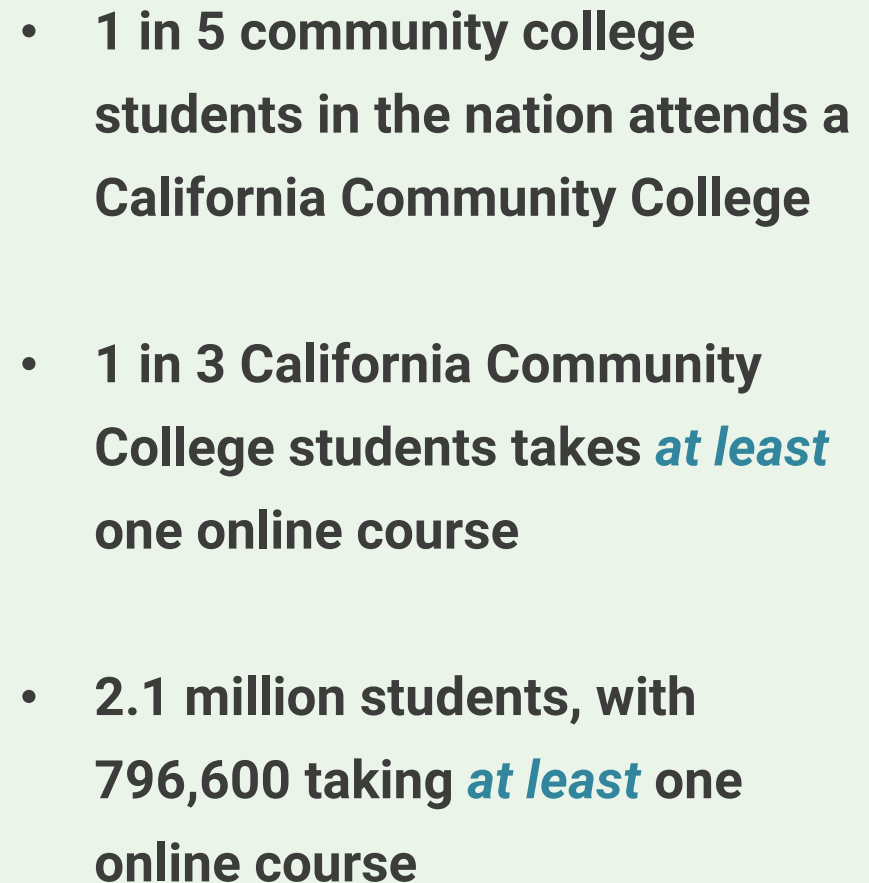

- provides the mechanism for reciprocity agreements.



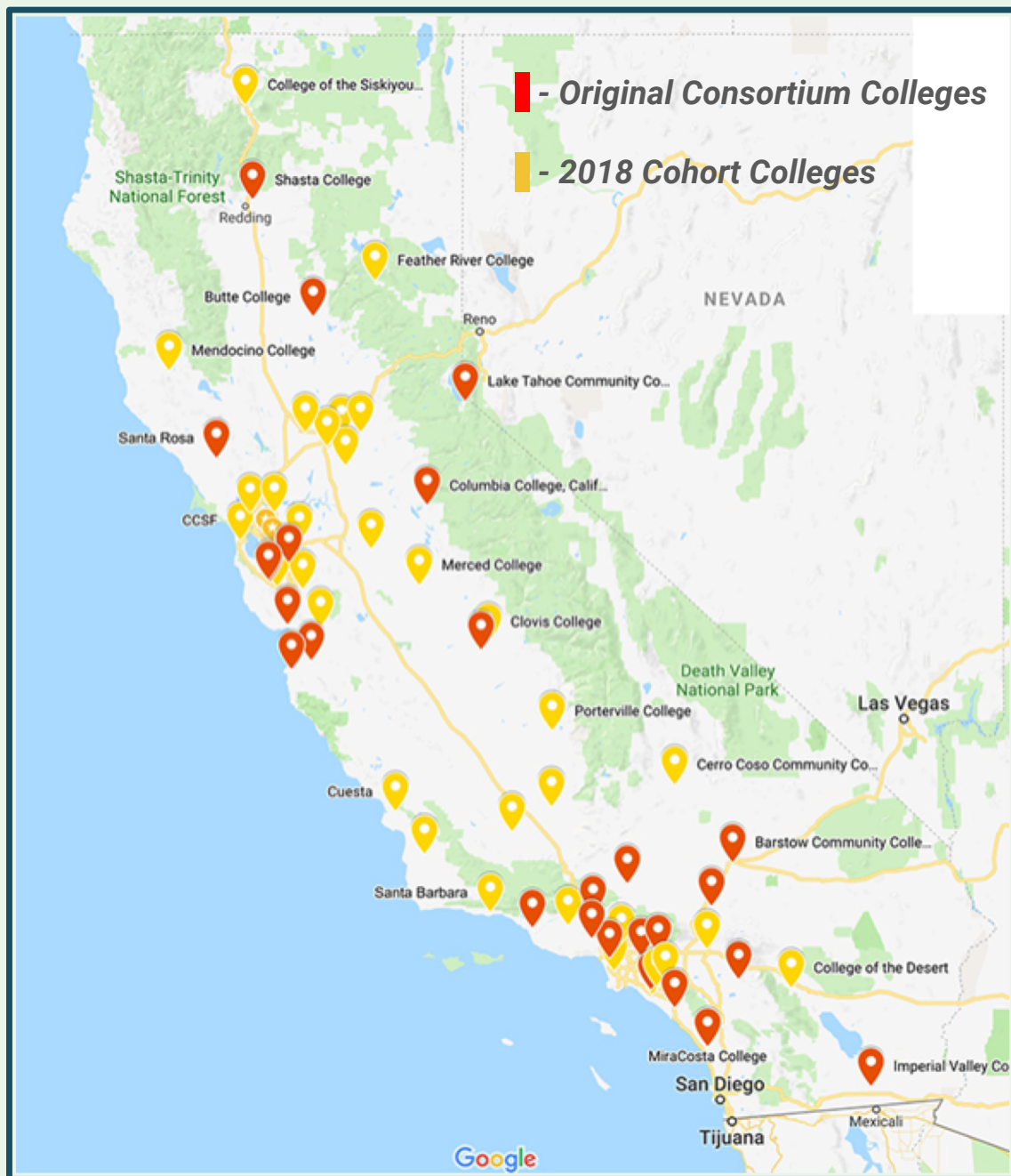

- Coordinates communication.

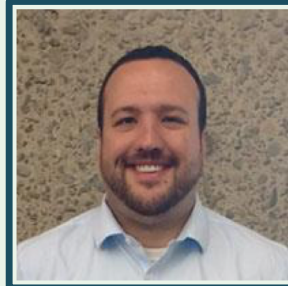

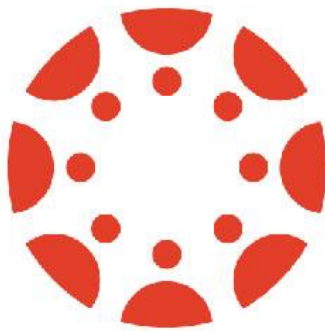

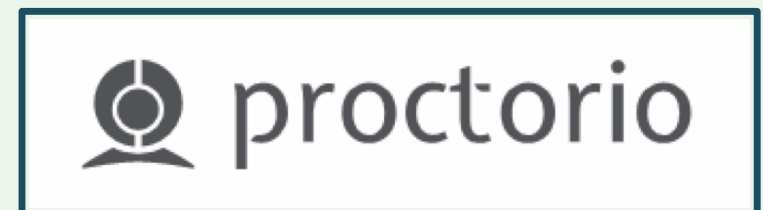

@ONE (Online Network of Educators)



Since 2014, OEI has partnered with @ONE to:

- develop and utilize a course quality rubric.
- develop and utilize a course review process.
- provide training on Canvas (CCMS).
- prepare greater numbers of faculty to teach online.



PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- **Course design recommendations from fellow faculty.**
- **Assistance getting the most from the tools in Canvas.**
- **Accessibility assistance to make the course fully 508 compliant!**

SUCCESS OF COLLABORATION

Since 2014,

- 68+ faculty (42 colleges) have been trained in the **Peer Online Course Review (POCR)** process.
- 115 courses have been evaluated and redesigned.
- 66 additional courses are under review.
- Numerous (20+) colleges have adopted the **OEI Course Design Rubric** as their local standard.
