

Since 2014, OEI has partnered with @ONE to:

- develop and utilize a course quality rubric.
- develop and utilize a course review process.
- provide training on Canvas (CCMS).
- prepare greater numbers of faculty to teach online.



PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT



Participants receive:

- Course design recommendations from fellow faculty.
- Assistance getting the most from the tools in Canvas.
- Accessibility assistance to make the course fully 508 compliant!
- Badges awarded as course is aligned with Course Design Rubric.



SUCCESS OF COLLABORATION

Since 2014,

- 68+ faculty (42 colleges) have been trained in the
 Peer Online Course Review (POCR) process.
- 115 courses have been evaluated and redesigned.
- 66 additional courses are under review.
- Numerous (20+) colleges have adopted the OEI
 Course Design Rubric as their local standard.
