1 Focus relentlessly on students' end goals.

Getting students to their individual educational goals—whether a degree, certificate, transfer, or specific skill set—should be the explicit focus of the CCCs. More than just offering courses, colleges need to be offering pathways to specific outcomes and providing supports for students to stay on those paths until completion.







- This is what your Media page will look like when you first access your account.
- To add media, click on the "Add/Upload Media" button.















- Refresh your page






- While your file is being processed, you will see under the "status" column that the file is marked "Uploaded".
- Depending on the size, it could take a few minutes to become "Available", meaning that the file is ready for you to work with.









- After clicking "Next" go back to "Media" & refresh your page

















