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What is the CVC-OEI?

- **California Virtual Campus-Online Education Initiative (CVC-OEI)**
 - Established in 2013-14 with a mission to significantly expand access to quality online courses that accelerate student completion
 - Common platforms (Canvas, Cranium Café, etc.)
 - Common quality standards for course design
 - Identification of “bottleneck” transfer courses
 - Create online exchange to expand access across CCCs
 - Renewed with expanded scope in 2018

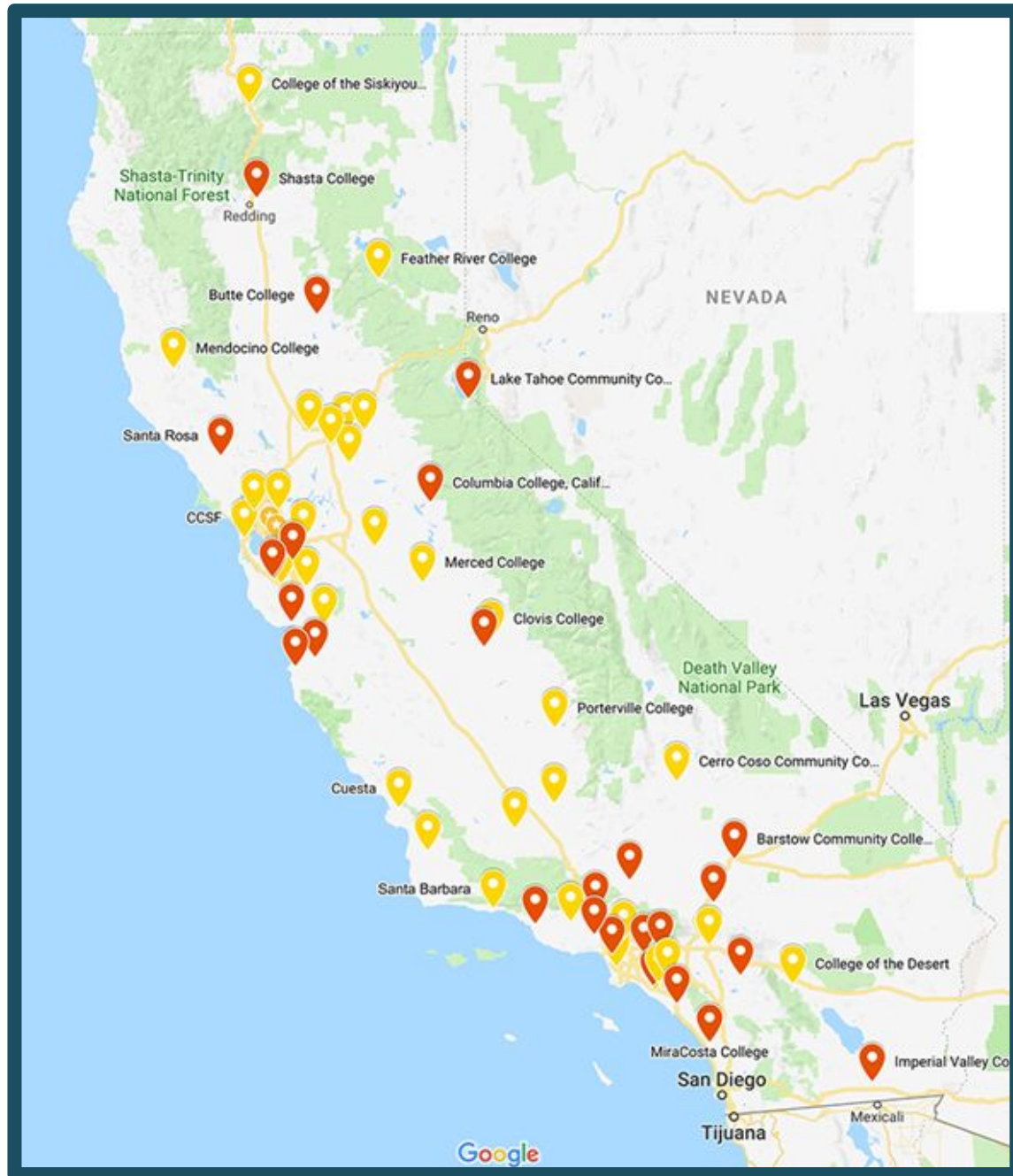

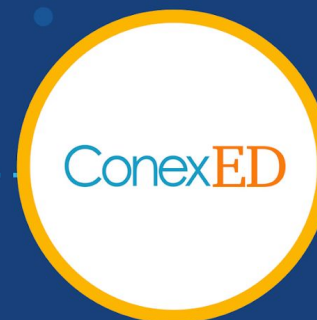

The CVC-OEI Course Design Academy is a free, online professional development program for full and part-time California Community College faculty teaching online at one of the [CVC-OEI consortium colleges](#). As a participant in the Course Design Academy, you receive:

- Confidential feedback and course design recommendations from fellow online faculty through peer online course review.
- Support from a Canvas Course Design Specialist (CCDS) to assist you with applying your feedback and getting the most from the tools and features in Canvas.
- Hands-on assistance, as needed, from Accessibility Specialists to make your course fully 508 compliant!
- Badges awarded as you align your course with each section of the CVC-OEI Course Design Rubric: Content

CVC-OEI Course Design Academy: For Faculty

STEP 1: Get Informed

Connect with your Campus POCR Lead and attend a Faculty Information Meeting.

STEP 2: Get Prepared

Align as much of your course as you can using the *Course Review Prep* form. Send the completed form to your Campus POCR Lead.

STEP 3: Get Submitted

Ask your Campus POCR Lead to submit your course through the online *Course Review Request* form.



STEP 6: Get Badged!

Your aligned course will receive a Quality Reviewed Badge that will allow it to rise to the top of the student search at CVC.edu!

STEP 5: Get Aligned

Follow your action plan with the help of your CVC-OEI Instructional Designer. Commit to 3-4 hours per week to align your course in 12-16 weeks.

STEP 4: Get Reviewed

Follow the steps on the *Reviewer Access Checklist* so the review team can begin reviewing your course.

- Lead to more **engaging and satisfactory online experiences**.
- Create a **community of practice** for online teaching.
- Result in more aligned "**Quality Reviewed**" courses in the CVC Exchange.

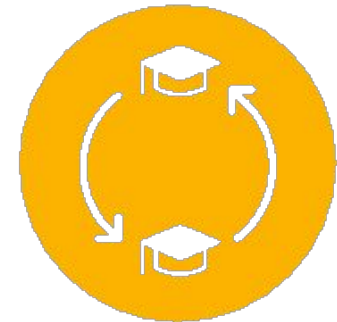

CVC-OEI Cross Enrollment ExCEL

What is the Cross Enrollment?

Cross enrollment allows students through cvc.edu to enroll for online classes at teaching colleges without filling out a separate application.

It will give students greater access to online courses and allows them to complete their programs on time.

Consortium College Commitment

- Implementation of essential Ecosystem Tools (Tutoring, Counseling, Readiness) or local equivalent
- Development of Local Peer Online Review Process to extend of local resources
- 20% of online class sections aligned to the rubric within two years
- Development of local implementation team and commitment to activate Finish Faster and ExCEL technology

CVC-OEI Consortium Membership Value Averages

- Colleges with 2000-10000 Enrollments per year
~\$100,000/year in services
- Colleges with 10,000-15,000 Enrollments per year
~\$160,000/year in services
- Colleges with 15,000-40,000 Enrollments per year
~\$230,000/year in services

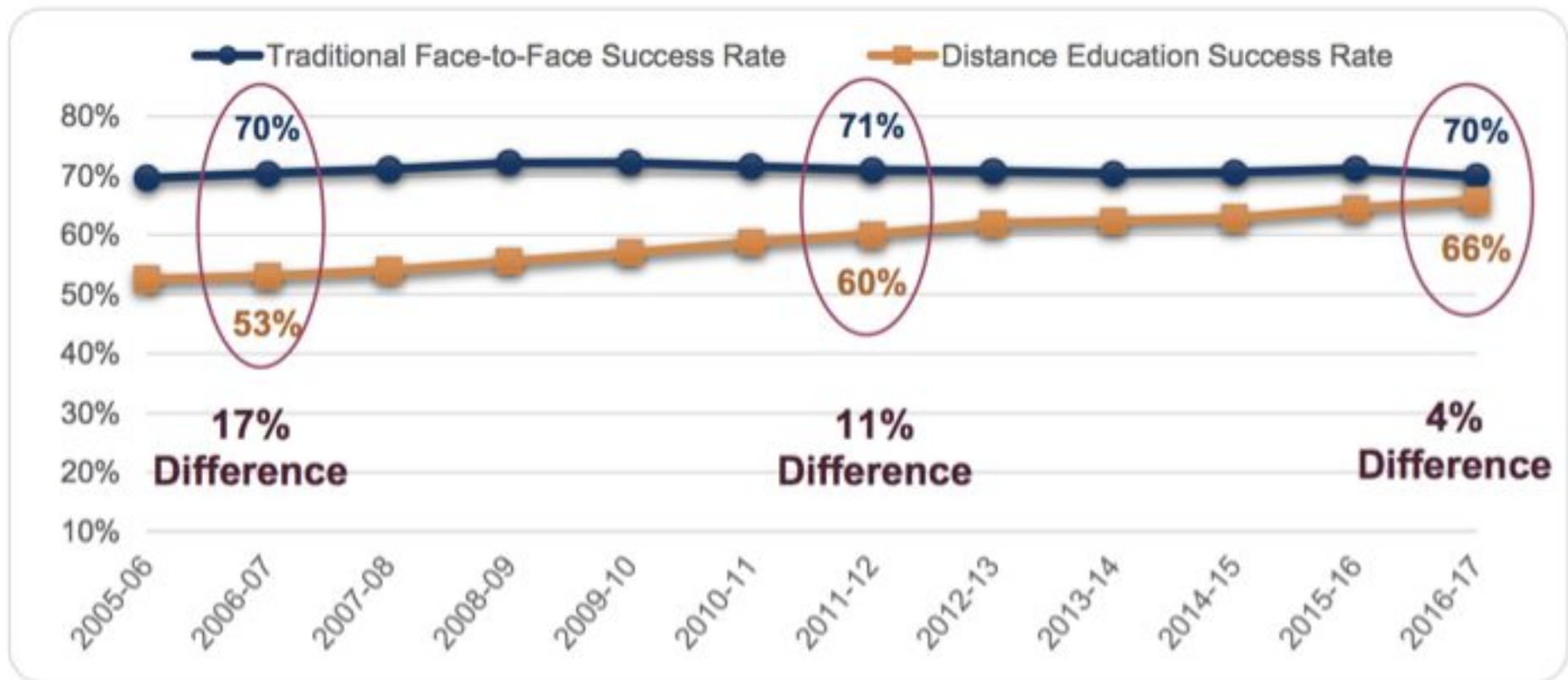

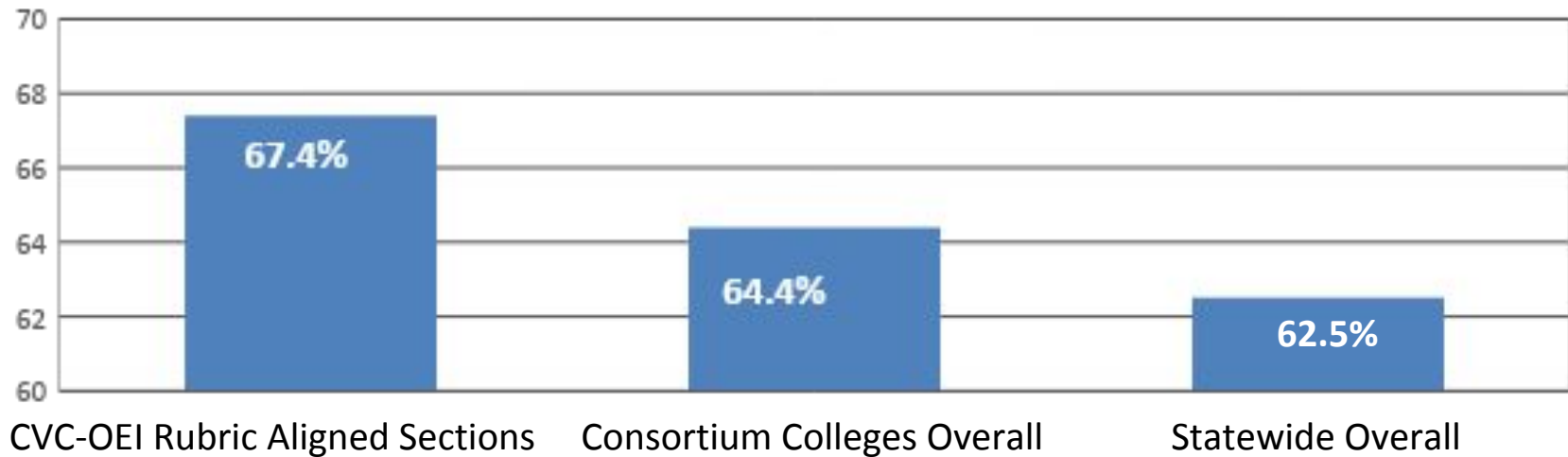
