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7 Principles of Personalizing Learning

Co-Planning Learning

Students and instructors share responsibility to develop a personalized learning plan to ensure that students are achieving in required and chosen areas

Why is this important?

EVERYTHING in life is personalized (greeting cards, seat position in your car, the camera on our phones) so why shouldn't the most important thing we participate in also be personalized?

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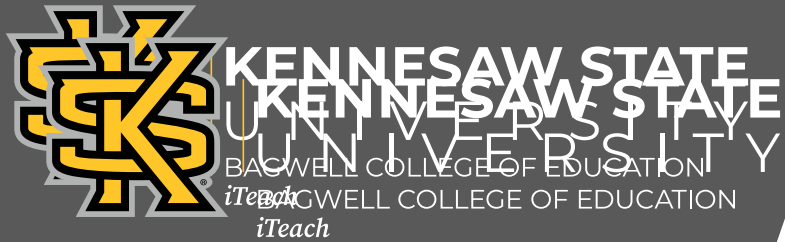
Mastery Based Assessment

Assessments should not be the deciding factor. Mastery based assessments allow students to continue the learning process until they have mastered the skill.

Why is this important?

Mastery based assessments allow instructors and students to have a deeper understanding of how, when, and by what means students can achieve. Mastery based assessment emphasizes what students have **achieved** while identifying areas of **needed support**.

Choice for Demonstrating Learning

Students have multiple pathways to demonstrate their understanding of curriculum.

Why is this important?

Classrooms, traditional and online, continue to become more diverse each year. A recent study by *Education Today* states that more than 50% of our students come from diverse backgrounds and more than 80% of these students are “non-traditional”! Not all of our learners will learn the same way!

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Choice and Voice

Students have an opportunity to express their own learning styles and learning preferences.

Why is this important?

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Varied Strategies

Teachers provide instruction to students using a variety of research backed instructional strategies. In turn, students become accustomed to research based learning strategies.

Why is this important?

Everything we are trying to accomplish in personalizing learning begins with effective instruction. As we provide **personalized instruction** to our students, it stems from the understandings that there is no single strategy that works for every learner.

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Flexible Pacing

Students move through a required curriculum at a pace that is accommodating to their skills and abilities.
