What does an Accessibility Checker do?

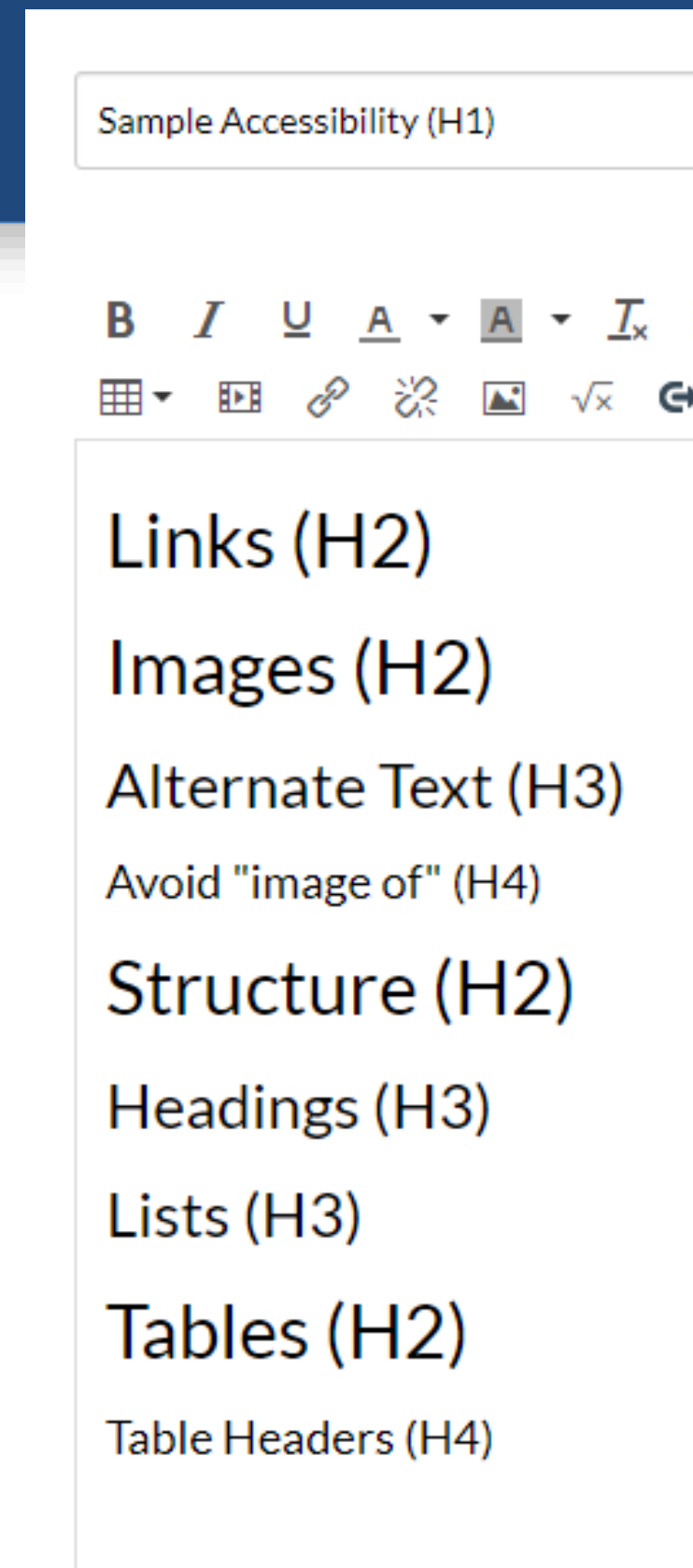
- **It aids with manually checking a course**
- **It provides a snapshot of common errors**
- **It gives tips and hints on how to fix accessibility errors**
- **It makes remediation simpler for HTML based pages**

What does it mean to be accessible in Canvas?

- **Heading styles are consistently used**
- **Lists are properly formatted**
- **Links are unique and descriptive**
- **Tables have designated row and column headers**
- **Every image in the course has descriptive alternative text**
- **There is sufficient contrast between background and foreground colors**
- **Visual elements are not used as the sole method of conveying importance of information**
- **Files in the course are accessible**
- **Videos are captioned**
- **Audio has a transcript**

Headings in Canvas (1)

Headings provide multiple benefits, but for a student using a screen reader, it allows them to navigate more effectively. Effective use of headings can allow that student to drill down to what they need to access rather than requiring that they read through the whole page.

What is Lorem Ipsum?

Lorem Ipsum is simply dummied text of the printing and typesetting industry. Lorem Ipsum has been the industry's standard dummy text ever since the 1500s when an unknown printer took a galley of type and scrambled it to make a type specimen book. It has survived not only five centuries, but also the leap into electronic typesetting, remaining essentially unchanged. It was popularised in the 1960s with the release of Letraset sheets containing Lorem Ipsum passages, and more recently with desktop publishing software like Aldus PageMaker including versions of Lorem Ipsum. Why do we use it?

It is a long established fact that a reader will be distracted by the readable content of a page when looking at its layout. The point of using Lorem Ipsum is that it has a more-or-less normal distribution of letters, as opposed to using 'Content here, content here', making it look like readable English. Many desktop publishing packages and web page editors now use Lorem Ipsum as their default model text, and a search for 'lorem ipsum' will uncover many web sites still in their infancy. Various versions have evolved over the years, sometimes by accident, sometimes on purpose (injected humor and the like).

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Lists

Lists are handled differently by screen readers and can be confusing to read if used improperly. Properly designed lists can be copied to other software while maintaining the structure, which might assist students in responding to prompts.

Bulleted lists are for lists where order is unimportant

- . Bread**
- . Milk**
- . Cheese**

Numbered lists are for lists where order is important

- 1. Read the directions**
- 2. Fill out the form**
- 3. Send in the form**

Table Headers

Week	Date	Chapter
1	January 2 – 5	5,7,8
2	January 14 – 18	2, 3

Tables must have headers for people using screen readers to navigate.

Avoid using tables for layout purposes.

The Accessibility Checker in Canvas

Pros

- **Row and Column headers**
- **Table Captions**
- **Color Contrast**
- **Built in / Convenient**

Limitations

- **Does not always catch the file name in alternate text**
- **Does not check files**
- **Does not check improperly formatted links**

Wave Toolbar

Pros

- **Review entire page at once**
- **Interface is clear on 'how many errors' exist.**
- **Clear explanations of errors**

Limitations

- **Visual icons can impede on design of page / they don't always show up**
- **Does not review files**
- **Must first find errors, then go in and fix**

Pros

- **Scan entire course quickly**
- **Dashboard that displays where exactly the error is located**
- **Strong suggestion area for common accessibility elements**
- **Fix some errors directly from dashboard**

Limitations

- **False positives for videos with closed captioning**
- **False positives for color contrast**
- **LTI integration – may need campus resources to install**
- **Does not check files**

Pope Tech LTI

Pros

- **Scan entire course quickly**
- **Dashboard for entire school and individual courses**
- **Fix errors directly from dashboard**
- **Uses the WAVE tool on backend**

Limitations

- **LTI integration – may need campus resources to install**
- **Does not check files**
- **Does not check captioning for videos**
